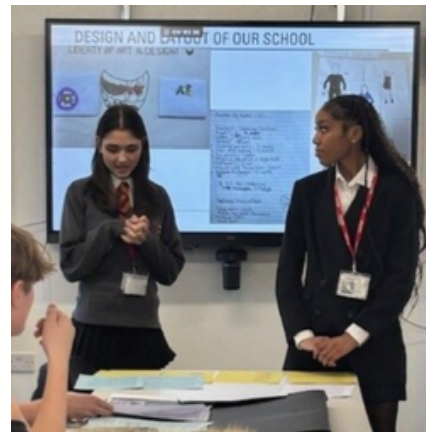


Careers

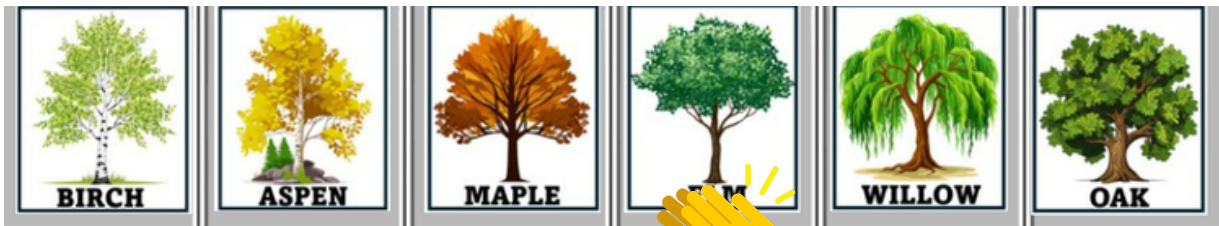
Return to Mainstream
