- ◆ Allow students to experience the working world and give them an understanding about the world outside of school

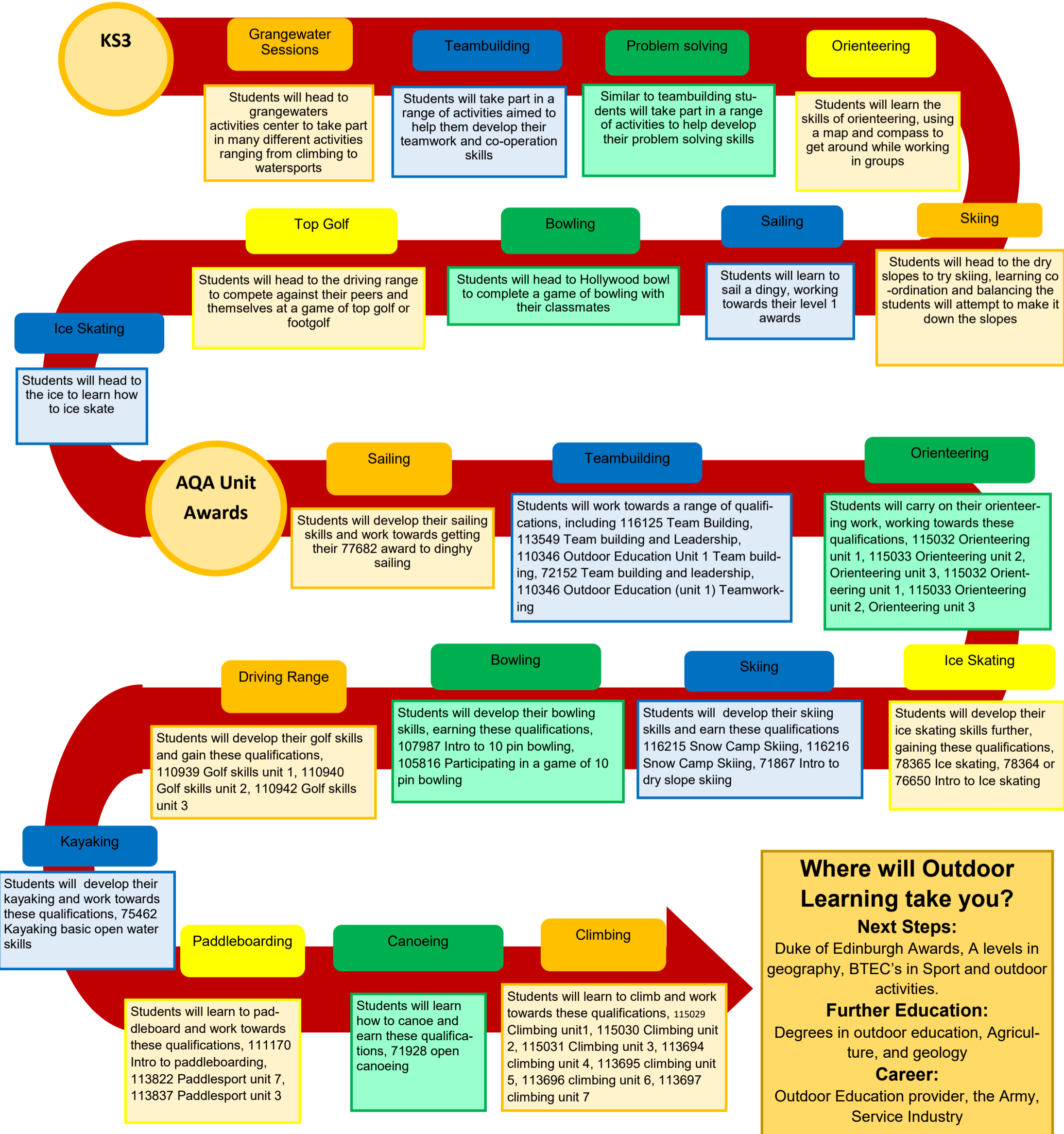
Our Core Values
