## Expectations: COVID-19

- Our approach to behaviour remains the same
- We will go through the expectations with parents and carers before a pupil arrives at the academy
- On arrival for the first time to the academy, we will go through the expectations with each pupil
- We will give regular reminders about the expectations e.g. handwashing
- We will keep these expectations and guidelines under review



## Non-Negotiables

- Wash your hands or use the hand sanitizer frequently and for 20 seconds when you:
  - Arrive at school and throughout the day
  - Blow your nose, sneeze or cough
  - Eat or handle food
- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve (not your hands) when you cough or sneeze and throw the tissue away straight away
- Follow any new signs around the academy
- Keep a 2m distance from yourself and other people around the academy

## Non-Negotiables

- Only enter the rooms designated for your activities / learning
- Follow instructions about breaks, lunch and snacks
- Leave any space you have used tidy and clean.
- If you feel uneasy about anything during the day, please speak to a member of staff

- Ask for help if you do not understand an instruction or information that's given to you
- Remember that by helping others we often help ourselves

<b>GOLD STAGE</b> 3+ Olive Character Points	<b>Exceptional Olive behaviours</b> Exceptional in readiness to learn, respect and safety	<b>GREEN STAGE</b> 2 Olive Character Points	<b>Embedded Olive behaviours</b> Be ready to learn Be respectful Be safe
<b>AMBER STAGE</b> 1 Olive Character Points	<b>Emerging Olive behaviours</b> Not yet consistently ready to learn, respectful and/or safe	<b>RED STAGE</b> 0 Olive Character Points	<b>Not yet Olive behaviours</b> Persistently not ready to learn, respectful or safe

## Character

- Staff will still be awarding character points at the end of every session, as normal.
- Points will be added to your current tally, as normal.
- Additional rewards will be given out each week, to those students who are really 'Daring to be Olive' during the sessions they are part of. Who arrive on time and are helpful and supportive of others.
